on Unallocated Government Land**

**Notes****Emergency works**

Works (including works on a slope or risk mitigation measures) needed to deal with severely deteriorated or failed slopes, including natural terrain, where life or property is threatened by a potential or actual landslide and/or boulder fall. Maintenance works are excluded. Funding to include the cost of works and clearance of debris arising from landslides on unallocated Government land, as well as the cost of any necessary investigation and consultancy fees.

- # - For man-made slopes affecting HyD roads with the slopes maintained by other departments, the responsible party and funding source is the department assigned by SIMAR to be responsible for maintaining the slopes.
  - ^ - Includes AFCD roads, HAD roads, waterworks access roads, military roads, etc.

  - \*\* - As defined in WBTC No. 26/99. For unallocated Government land Category 5(e) and 5(f) as defined in Appendix A to WBTC No. 26/99, the emergency works are to be funded by CEDD's Block Allocation 5101CX and by CEDD's Block Allocation 5101CX/LandsD respectively.
- Funding comes from the LPM Block Allocation 5001BX except for emergency works to registered natural terrain mitigation measures (e.g. barriers) for which the respective maintenance department is responsible. If a Government works agent other than HyD is engaged to carry out the emergency works, the works agent may obtain an allocation warrant or works expenditure authorization from the GEO's LPM Branch for the cost of the works upon confirmation of the eligibility of the works in respect of the funding source by a GEO District Division.
