

**Approved Work List for  
Exemption from Temporary Decking over Excavation not being Worked On**

Without prejudice to the requirements of temporary decking over an excavation under the following circumstances where–

- i) restricted hours imposed by the relevant authorities during which the Work under the Permit cannot be carried out;
- ii) temporary traffic arrangements required or approved by the relevant authorities;
- iii) an excavation exceeding a maximum length that can be fenced off and opened at any time approved by the relevant authorities,

the works included in the table below are exempted for temporary decking over an excavation not being worked on during any day pursuant to clause 37(B) of Excavation Permit Conditions (or clause 35(B) of Emergency Excavation Permit Conditions).

| Description of works |   |
|----------------------|---|
| 1.                   | Excavation along carriageway with a full single-lane width or more.   |
| 2.                   | Excavation along footway or cycletrack where a minimum unobstructed width of 1.5m is provided and maintained. |
| 3.                   | Excavation where temporary shoring support is installed.  |
| 4.                   | Leakage test for gas pipes or water mains.  |
| 5.                   | Curing of fresh concrete after completion of road reinstatement works.  |
