

## **Road Tunnels of Hong Kong**

Over the past 50 years, a number of road tunnels have been built in Hong Kong.

The first road tunnel in Hong Kong is the Lion Rock Tunnel built in 1967. It provides a direct road link between Sha Tin and Kowloon. The first cross-harbour tunnel, which connects Causeway Bay and Hung Hom, was built in 1972. In the 80s, more and more road tunnels were built to cope with the rapid urban and new town developments. These tunnels include the Aberdeen Tunnel, Kai Tak Tunnel, Eastern Harbour Crossing, Shing Mun Tunnel, Tseung Kwan O Tunnel and Tate's Cairn Tunnel. Relocation of the airport to Chek Lap Kok in the 90s triggered new traffic demand. To meet such demand, the Western Harbour Crossing, Cheung Tsing Tunnel and Tai Lam Tunnel were built in 1997/98. A decade later, four road tunnels, namely the Nam Wan Tunnel, Eagle's Nest Tunnel, Sha Tin Heights Tunnel and Tai Wai Tunnel, comprising the section of Route 8 between Cheung Sha Wan and Sha Tin, were

completed. They serve as the fourth road link between Sha Tin and Kowloon which helps relieve traffic pressure on the Lion Rock Tunnel, Tate's Cairn Tunnel and Tai Po Road. The Scenic Hill Tunnel and Airport Tunnel were built in 2018. They form part of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Hong Kong Link Road and the connecting road between the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Hong Kong Port artificial island and Chek Lap Kok respectively. The Lung Shan Tunnel and Cheung Shan Tunnel were commissioned in May 2019. These two tunnels form part of the Heung Yuen Wai Highway connecting Fanling Highway to Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point. The Tuen Mun-Chek Lap Kok Tunnel, commissioned in December 2020, connects Pillar Point in Tuen Mun South and the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Hong Kong Port. It is Hong Kong's first sub-sea road tunnel using tunnel boring machines to construct, and is also the longest tunnel in Hong Kong.
