Reply:

The investigation study of Widening of T6 Bridge of Tate's Cairn Highway project was completed in the fourth quarter of 2023. Based on the findings of the investigation study, the Highways Department (HyD) is currently actively exploring practical options to implement the said project from multiple angles, which include optimising the design of widened sections of the bridge, studying arrangements for advance utility diversion and introducing innovative design and construction technologies, etc. The aim is to reduce the project's construction costs and shorten the construction duration. The Government will continue to review the cost-effectiveness of the project and implement the relevant project in a timely and orderly manner according to priority and urgency.
