

Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370)

Scheme annexed to Plan No. NCWBR/GZP/101 under section 5 describing

PWP Item No. 6812TH – Retrofitting of Noise Barriers on New Clear Water Bay Road

General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (“the Ordinance”), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. NCWBR/GZP/101 (“the Plan”) annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed road works are required to mitigate the traffic noise along the section of New Clear Water Bay Road fronting Choi Wan Estates.

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2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows: –
 - (i) installation of a cantilevered noise barrier at the section of New Clear Water Bay Road near Ngan Ho House of Choi Wan (I) Estate;
 - (ii) installation of two sections of semi-enclosures at the sections of New Clear Water Bay Road near Pak Hung House and Boon Yuet House of Choi Wan (I) Estate and Kai Fai House of Choi Wan (II) Estate respectively;
 - (iii) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing amenity area into footpath;
 - (iv) temporary closure and reinstatement of sections of the existing

carriageway and footpaths; and

- (v) ancillary works including civil and geotechnical, utility diversion, street lighting, landscaping, traffic aids and drainage works.

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Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently a section of the existing amenity area; and to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas within the limit of works area as shown on the Plan. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

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Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any gas, electricity, water or telecommunications service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, gas mains, drainage pipes, and any other service apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired,

will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
