KWUN TONG LINE EXTENSION
NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
THE OPEN SPACE IN WUHU STREET TEMPORARY PLAYGROUND;
PART OF THE OPEN SPACE IN YAN FUNG STREET REST GARDEN;
A FOOTBRIDGE WITH LIFTS AND STAIRCASES ACROSS
CHATHAM ROAD NORTH CONNECTING TO WUHU STREET; AND
A FOOTPATH AT THE NORTHWEST OF CHATHAM ROAD NORTH
NEAR YAN FUNG STREET REST GARDEN

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 2 March 2012 (the ‘Order’), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary closure of the open space in Wuhu Street Temporary Playground, as delineated and shown in pink on Plan numbered KTE/G03/0006/1;
- (II) the temporary closure of part of the open space in Yan Fung Street Rest Garden, as delineated and shown in orange on Plan numbered KTE/G03/0006/1;
- (III) the temporary partial closure of a footbridge with lifts and staircases across Chatham Road North connecting to Wuhu Street, as delineated and shown in yellow on Plan numbered KTE/G03/0006/1; and
- (IV) the temporary partial closure of a footpath at the northwest of Chatham Road North near Yan Fung Street Rest Garden, as delineated and shown in red on Plan numbered KTE/G03/0006/1,

during the period from 26 March 2012 to 25 March 2013 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Kwun Tong Line Extension. A description of the works to be carried out and the parts of the open spaces, the footbridge and the footpath to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plan numbered KTE/G03/0006/1 (the ‘Plan’) may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the open spaces, the footbridge and the footpath affected by the Order on 9 March 2012.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the open spaces, the footbridge and the footpath or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the open spaces, the footbridge and the footpath affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the open spaces, the footbridge and the footpath or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

(a) The open space in Wuhu Street Temporary Playground, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered KTE/G03/0006/1.	The open space will be temporarily closed for the construction and alteration of the footbridge and the construction of the associated railway facilities of the Kwun Tong Line Extension.
(b) Part of the open space in Yan Fung Street Rest Garden, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered KTE/G03/0006/1.	The open space will be temporarily closed for the construction and alteration of the footbridge and the construction of the associated railway facilities of the Kwun Tong Line Extension.
(c) A footbridge with lifts and staircases across Chatham Road North connecting to Wuhu Street, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered KTE/G03/0006/1.	Parts of the footbridge with lifts and staircases will be temporarily closed for the construction and alteration of the footbridge and the construction of the associated railway facilities of the Kwun Tong Line Extension.
(d) A footpath at the northwest of Chatham Road North near Yan Fung Street Rest Garden, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered KTE/G03/0006/1.	Parts of the footpath width will be temporarily closed for the construction and alteration of the footbridge and the construction of the associated railway facilities of the Kwun Tong Line Extension.

Statement on Personal Data
