KWUN TONG LINE EXTENSION

**AUTHORIZATION FOR
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE STAIRCASE OF A FOOTBRIDGE ACROSS
HUNG HOM ROAD CONNECTING TO BAUHINIA MANSIONS OF
WHAMPOA GARDEN; TAK OK STREET; AND
SECTIONS OF TAK FUNG STREET, TAK TING STREET AND
SHUNG KING STREET**

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize:–

- (I) the temporary partial closure of the section of Shung King Street between Tak On Street and Tak Hong Street, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered KTE/G04/0004/5 during the period from 1 June to 31 July 2015; and

- (II) (a) the temporary closure of the staircase of the footbridge across Hung Hom Road connecting to Bauhinia Mansions of Whampoa Garden, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered KTE/G04/0004/5;

- (b) the temporary partial closure of Tak On Street, as delineated and shown in purple on the Plan numbered KTE/G04/0004/5; and

- (c) the temporary partial closure of the section of Tak Fung Street between its junction with Tak On Street and a point about 80 metres southwest of the junction, the section of Tak Ting Street between its junction with Tak On Street and a point about 80 metres northeast of the junction, and the section of Shung King Street between Tak On Street and Tak Fung Street, as delineated and shown in blue, pink and red respectively on the Plan numbered KTE/G04/0004/5,

during the period from 1 June 2015 to 31 May 2016.

I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that all public or private rights in, upon, under or over (i) the section of the road as described in (I) above during the period from 1 June to 31 July 2015; and (ii) the staircase and the sections of the roads as described in (II) above during the period from 1 June 2015 to 31 May 2016, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
