## MTR TSIM SHA TSUI STATION CARNARVON ROAD SUBWAY AND ENTRANCES MODIFICATION WORKS

# NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF THE FOOTPATH OF CARNARVON ROAD; AND TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF CARNARVON ROAD, BRISTOL AVENUE AND NATHAN ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 2 October 2013 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the permanent closure of the section of the footpath of Carnarvon Road (near Entrance D2 of the MTR Tsim Sha Tsui Station), as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered CRS/G01/0001/1 with effect from 25 October 2013; and
- (II) (a) the temporary partial closure of the section of Carnarvon Road between Nathan Road and Bristol Avenue and the section of Carnarvon Road between its junction with Bristol Avenue and a point about 50 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow and pink respectively on the Plan numbered CRS/G01/0001/1; and
  - (b) the temporary partial closure of Bristol Avenue, and the section of Nathan Road between a point about 15 metres north of its junction with Carnarvon Road and a point about 15 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in green and blue respectively on the Plan numbered CRS/G01/0001/1,

during the period from 25 October 2013 to 24 October 2014,

for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the MTR Tsim Sha Tsui Station Carnarvon Road Subway and Entrances Modification Works. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the footpath and the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the footpath and the roads affected by the Order on 11 October 2013.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the footpath and the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the footpath and the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the footpath and the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

### **SCHEDULE**

The sections of the footpath and the roads to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which the sections of the footpath and the roads will be affected

(a) The section of the footpath of Carnarvon Road (near Entrance D2 of the MTR Tsim Sha Tsui Station), as delineated and shown in red on the Plan The footpath width will be permanently closed in connection with the modification works of Entrance D1 and Entrance D2 of the MTR Tsim Sha Tsui Station.

(b) The section of Carnarvon Road between Nathan Road and Bristol Avenue, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan. The carriageways and parts of the footpath widths will be temporarily closed in connection with the construction of a pedestrian subway underneath Carnarvon Road and other associated railway facilities, and the modification works of Entrance D1 and Entrance D2 of the MTR Tsim Sha Tsui Station.

(c) The section of Carnarvon Road between its junction with Bristol Avenue and a point about 50 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and show in pink on the Plan. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of a pedestrian subway underneath Carnaryon Road

(d) Bristol Avenue, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan.

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of a pedestrian subway underneath Carnaryon Road.

(e) The section of Nathan Road between a point about 15 metres north of its junction with Carnarvon Road and a point about 15 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed in connection with the construction of a pedestrian subway underneath Carnaryon Road.

#### Statement on Personal Data

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written claims as required under section 34 of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of the information, including the personal data, as required under section 34 of the Railways Ordinance is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under section 34 of the Railways Ordinance is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters.
