NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF NAM KOK ROAD, PRINCE EDWARD ROAD WEST, OLYMPIC AVENUE AND SUNG WONG TOI ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 6 January 2017 (the 'Order'), authorized:-

- (I) the temporary partial closure of the section of Nam Kok Road between Prince Edward Road West and Nga Tsin Wai Road, and the section of Prince Edward Road West between a point about 5 metres east of its junction with Nam Kok Road and a point about 20 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in red and pink respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G18/0013/5;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the section of Olympic Avenue between Dakota Drive and Hang Wan Road, as delineated and shown in beige on the Plan numbered SCL/G19/0010/4; and
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the section of Sung Wong Toi Road between a point about 60 metres east of its junction with Pak Tai Street and a point about 180 metres east of the junction, and the section of Sung Wong Toi Road between its junction with Hang Wan Road and a point about 100 metres south of the junction, both delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SCL/G19/0010/4.

during the period from 1 February 2017 to 31 January 2018 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway station and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.

(b) The section of Olympic Avenue between Dakota Drive and Hang Wan Road, as delineated and shown in beige on the Plan numbered SCL/G19/0010/4. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway station, railway tunnel and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link. (c) The section of Sung Wong Toi Road between a point about 60 metres east of its junction with Pak Tai Street and a point about 180 metres east of the junction, and the section of Sung Wong Toi Road between its junction with Hang Wan Road and a point about 100 metres south of the junction, both delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SCL/G19/0010/4.

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway station, railway tunnel and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.
