

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Notice under section 23)**

SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF FUNG TAK ROAD,
PO KONG VILLAGE ROAD AND SHUNG WAH STREET**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 22 March 2013 (the 'Order'), authorized:-

- (I) the temporary partial closure of a section of Fung Tak Road between a point about 250 metres east of its junction with Po Kong Village Road and a point about 40 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark green on the Plan numbered SCL/G09/0015/1;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of a section of Po Kong Village Road between a point about 120 metres northeast of its junction with Shung Wah Street and a point about 40 metres south of its junction with Fung Tak Road, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SCL/G09/0015/1; and
- (III) the temporary partial closure of a section of Shung Wah Street between its junction with Po Kong Village Road and a point about 30 metres northwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered SCL/G09/0015/1,

during the period from 19 April 2013 to 18 April 2014 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out and the areas of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected are given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plan numbered SCL/G09/0015/1 (the 'Plan') may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:-

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads affected by the Order on 5 April 2013.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.
