NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY ALTERATION OF SECTIONS OF MARSH ROAD, TONNOCHY ROAD, HUNG HING ROAD, FLEMING ROAD, EXPO DRIVE EAST, EXPO DRIVE CENTRAL AND CONVENTION AVENUE; AND TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF HARBOUR ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 30 March 2021 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary alteration of the section of Marsh Road between its junction with Hung Hing Road and a point about 30 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G34/0054/4;
- (II) the temporary alteration of the section of Tonnochy Road between its junction with Hung Hing Road and its junction with Harbour Road, and the section of Hung Hing Road between its junction with Convention Avenue and a point about 330 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in orange and yellow respectively on the Plans numbered SCL/G34/0054/4 and SCL/G35/0054/12;
- (III) the temporary alteration of the section of Fleming Road between its junction with Harbour Road and its junction with Convention Avenue, the section of Expo Drive East between its junction with Convention Avenue and a point about 180 metres north of the junction, the section of Expo Drive Central between its junction with Expo Drive East and a point about 35 metres west of the junction, and the section of Convention Avenue between its junction with Fleming Road and a point about 200 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in green, blue, brown and purple respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G35/0054/12; and
- (IV) the temporary partial closure of the section of Harbour Road between its junction with Tonnochy Road and a point about 70 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in red on the Plans numbered SCL/G34/0054/4 and SCL/G35/0054/12,

during the period from 1 May to 31 December 2021 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing so as to reach the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the alteration/closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order. Claims can be submitted via one of the following means:—

Notice is hereby given that further alteration/closure of the same part or parts of the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for alteration/closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

- (a) The section of Marsh Road between its junction with Hung Hing Road and a point about 30 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G34/0054/4.
- (b) The section of Tonnochy Road between its junction with Hung Hing Road and its junction with Harbour Road, and the section of Hung Hing Road between its junction with Convention Avenue and a point about 330 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in orange and yellow respectively on the Plans numbered SCL/G34/0054/4 and SCL/G35/0054/12.

The carriageways and footpaths will be temporarily altered with a shift in alignment in close proximity to facilitate the construction of the railway station and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.

(c) The section of Fleming Road between its junction with Harbour Road and its junction with Convention Avenue, the section of Expo Drive East between its junction with Convention Avenue and a point about 180 metres north of the junction, and the section of Convention Avenue between its junction with Fleming Road and a point about 200 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in green, blue and purple respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G35/0054/12.

The carriageways and footpaths will be temporarily altered with a shift in alignment in close proximity to facilitate the construction of the railway station, railway tunnel and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.

(d) The section of Expo Drive Central between its junction with Expo Drive East and a point about 35 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in brown on the Plan numbered SCL/G35/0054/12.

The carriageways and footpaths will be temporarily altered with a shift in alignment in close proximity to facilitate the construction of the railway station and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.

(e) The section of Harbour Road between its junction with Tonnochy Road and a point about 70 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in red on the Plans numbered SCL/G34/0054/4 and SCL/G35/0054/12.

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway station and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.
