NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF THE ROAD ADJACENT TO MTR CHE KUNG TEMPLE STATION, CHE KUNG MIU ROAD, ON MUK STREET AND ON MING STREET

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 16 April 2013 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary partial closure of the section of the road adjacent to MTR Che Kung Temple Station between its two junctions with Che Kung Miu Road; and the section of Che Kung Miu Road near its junction with Sha Tin Tau Road (near Entrance B of the MTR Che Kung Temple Station), as delineated and shown in red and purple respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G39/0017/1, and
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the section of On Muk Street between a point about 10 metres southeast of its junction with On Kwan Street and a point about 30 metres southeast of its junction with On Ming Street; and the section of On Ming Street between a point about 20 metres northeast of its junction with On Muk Street and a point about 20 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in blue and yellow respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G42/0017/1,

during the period from 10 May 2013 to 9 May 2014 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

SCHEDULE

The roads to be affected Description of the works and the manner in which the roads will be affected

(a) The section of the road adjacent to MTR Che Kung Temple Station between its two junctions with Che Kung Miu Road; and the section of Che Kung Miu Road near its junction with Sha Tin Tau Road (near Entrance B of the MTR Che Kung Temple Station), as delineated and shown in red and purple respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G39/0017/1. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the modification works of the MTR Che Kung Temple Station in relation to the Shatin to Central Link.

(b) The section of On Muk Street between a point about 10 metres southeast of its junction with On Kwan Street and a point about 30 metres southeast of its junction with On Ming Street; and the section of On Ming Street between a point about 20 metres northeast of its junction with On Muk Street and a point about 20 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in blue and yellow respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G42/0017/1

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the modification works of the MTR Shek Mun Station in relation to the Shatin to Central Link.

Statement on Personal Data
