

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Notice under section 23)**

SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY ALTERATION OF A SECTION OF
CHE KUNG MIU ROAD AND A PART OF HIN KENG BUS TERMINUS; AND
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF CHE KUNG MIU ROAD,
HIN KENG STREET, KENG HAU ROAD AND THE ROAD CONNECTING
EX-NEW TERRITORIES SOUTH ANIMAL MANAGEMENT CENTER AND
CHE KUNG MIU ROAD**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 23 April 2014 (the ‘Order’), authorized:-

- (I) the temporary alteration of the section of Che Kung Miu Road between its junction with Keng Hau Road and the entrance of Hin Keng Bus Terminus, and the part of Hin Keng Bus Terminus, as delineated and shown in brown and green respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G03/0037/1; and
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the section of Che Kung Miu Road between a point about 45 metres northeast of its junction with Hin Keng Street and a point about 50 metres southwest of the junction, the section of Hin Keng Street between its junction with Che Kung Miu Road and a point about 60 metres southeast of the junction, the section of Keng Hau Road between its junction with Che Kung Miu Road and a point about 50 metres west of the junction, and the section of the road connecting ex-New Territories South Animal Management Center and Che Kung Miu Road, as delineated and shown in red, yellow, blue and beige respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G03/0037/1,

during the period from 16 May 2014 to 15 May 2015 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads and the part of the bus terminus to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plan numbered SCL/G03/0037/1 (the ‘Plan’) may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:-

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads and the bus terminus affected by the Order on 2 May 2014.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure/alteration of the relevant part or parts of the roads and the bus terminus or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads and the bus terminus affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure/alteration of the same part or parts of the roads and the bus terminus or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure/alteration will be published if and when such an order is made.

SCHEDULE

The roads and the bus terminus to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which the roads and the bus terminus will be affected

(a) The section of Che Kung Miu Road between its junction with Keng Hau Road and the entrance of Hin Keng Bus Terminus, and the part of Hin Keng Bus Terminus, as delineated and shown in brown and green respectively on the Plan.

The carriageways and footpaths will be temporarily altered such that the existing roundabout at the junction of Che Kung Miu Road and Keng Hau Road will be temporarily relocated to the section of Che Kung Miu Road adjoining the entrance of Hin Keng Bus Terminus to facilitate the construction of the railway station at Hin Keng and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.

(b) The section of Che Kung Miu Road between a point about 45 metres northeast of its junction with Hin Keng Street and a point about 50 metres southwest of the junction, the section of Hin Keng Street between its junction with Che Kung Miu Road and a point about 60 metres southeast of the junction, the section of Keng Hau Road between its junction with Che Kung Miu Road and a point about 50 metres west of the junction, and the section of the road connecting ex-New Territories South Animal Management Center and Che Kung Miu Road, as delineated and shown in red, yellow, blue and beige respectively on the Plan.

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway station at Hin Keng and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.

Statement on Personal Data

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written claims as required under section 34 of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of the information, including the personal data, as required under section 34 of the Railways Ordinance is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under section 34 of the Railways Ordinance is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected.
