NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING RECLAMATION OF AND OTHER WORKS OVER AND UPON THE GOVERNMENT FORESHORE AND SEA-BED AT SHEK O QUARRY

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 10 June 2014 (the 'Order'), authorized the reclamation of and other works over and upon the Government foreshore and sea-bed at Shek O Quarry, as delineated and shown in green on the Plans numbered SCL/G52/0039/1 and SCL/G53/0039/1 during the period from 2 July 2014 to 31 March 2019 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the Government foreshore and sea-bed to be affected and the manner in which it will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the date of extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the Government foreshore and sea-bed affected by the Order.

The Government foreshore and sea-bed to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which the Government foreshore and seabed will be affected

The Government foreshore and sea-bed at Shek O Quarry, as delineated and shown in green on the Plans numbered SCL/G52/0039/1 and SCL/G53/0039/1.

The works involve site formation, operation of temporary fabrication yard, temporary barge loading/unloading facilities and temporary barge mooring area, where parts of the facilities will be extended to over and upon the Government foreshore and sea-bed (above sea level) to facilitate the construction of the Shatin to Central Link. The Government foreshore and sea-bed will be reinstated on completion of the railway works of the Shatin to Central Link.
