Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 10 December 2014 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary alteration of the section of Prince Edward Road West between its junction with Hau Wong Road and South Wall Road, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plans numbered SCL/G19/0042/1 and SCL/G22/0042/1;
- (II) the temporary closure of the pedestrian subway connecting Olympic Garden and the junction of Argyle Street and Prince Edward Road West, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plans numbered SCL/G19/0042/1 and SCL/G22/0042/1;
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the pedestrian subway connecting Olympic Garden and Prince Edward Road West, and the pedestrian subway connecting Olympic Garden and the junction of Argyle Street and Ma Tau Chung Road, as delineated and shown in yellow and orange respectively on the Plans numbered SCL/G19/0042/1 and SCL/G22/0042/1.

during the period from 1 January to 31 December 2015 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the section of the road and the pedestrian subways to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure/alteration of the relevant part or parts of the road and the pedestrian subways or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the road and pedestrian subways affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure/alteration of the same part or parts of the road and the pedestrian subways or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure/alteration will be published if and when such an order is made.

SCHEDULE

The road and the pedestrian subways to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which the road and pedestrian subways will be affected

(a) The section of Prince Edward Road West between its junctions with Hau Wong Road and South Wall Road, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plans numbered SCL/G19/0042/1 and SCL/G22/0042/1. The carriageway will be temporarily altered with a shift in alignment in close proximity and part of the footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway station, railway tunnel at To Kwa Wan and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.

(b) The pedestrian subway connecting Olympic Garden and the junction of Argyle Street and Prince Edward Road West, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plans numbered SCL/G19/0042/1 and SCL/G22/0042/1

The pedestrian subway will be temporarily closed to facilitate the modification of its structure and the construction of the entrance of the railway station at To Kwa Wan and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.

(c) The pedestrian subway connecting Olympic Garden and Prince Edward Road West, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plans numbered SCL/G19/0042/1 and SCL/G22/0042/1. Parts of the pedestrian subway will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the entrance of the railway station at To Kwa Wan and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link

(d) The pedestrian subway connecting Olympic Garden and the junction of Argyle Road and Ma Tau Chung Road, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plans numbered SCL/G19/0042/1 and SCL/G22/0042/1. Parts of the pedestrian subway will be temporarily closed to facilitate the modification of its structure and the construction of the entrance of the railway station at To Kwa Wan and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.
