

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Notice under section 23)**

SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF VICTORIA PARK ROAD;
PART OF WAN CHAI SPORTS GROUND, AND
WAN CHAI FERRY PUBLIC TRANSPORT INTERCHANGE; AND
TEMPORARY ALTERATION OF A SECTION OF CONVENTION AVENUE**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 1 December 2020 (the ‘Order’), authorized:–

- (I) the temporary partial closure of the section of Victoria Park Road between a point about 30 metres northwest of its junction with its slip roads and a point about 70 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G34/0069/1;
- (II) the temporary closure of part of Wan Chai Sports Ground, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plans numbered SCL/G34/0069/1 and SCL/G35/0069/1;
- (III) the temporary closure of Wan Chai Ferry Public Transport Interchange, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SCL/G35/0069/1; and
- (IV) the temporary alteration of the section of Convention Avenue between its junction with Tonnochy Road and its junction with Fleming Road, as delineated and shown in beige on the Plan numbered SCL/G35/0069/1,

during the period from 1 January to 31 December 2021 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads, the area of part of Wan Chai Sports Ground and the Wan Chai Ferry Public Transport Interchange to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads, Wan Chai Sports Ground and Wan Chai Ferry Public Transport Interchange affected by the Order on 18 December 2020.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing so as to reach the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the closure/alteration of the relevant part or parts of the roads, Wan Chai Sports Ground and Wan Chai Ferry Public Transport Interchange or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads, Wan Chai Sports Ground and Wan Chai Ferry Public Transport Interchange affected by the Order. Claims can be submitted via one of the following means:–

Notice is hereby given that further closure/alteration of the same part or parts of the roads, Wan Chai Sports Ground and Wan Chai Ferry Public Transport Interchange or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure/alteration will be published if and when such an order is made.
