NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE PEDESTRIAN SUBWAYS CONNECTING OLYMPIC GARDEN AND THE JUNCTION OF ARGYLE STREET AND PRINCE EDWARD ROAD WEST, AND CONNECTING OLYMPIC GARDEN AND THE JUNCTION OF ARGYLE STREET AND MA TAU CHUNG ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 7 February 2017 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary closure of the pedestrian subway connecting Olympic Garden and the junction of Argyle Street and Prince Edward Road West, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G22/0062/1, with details as follows:
 - (a) during the period from 1 March to 17 April 2017, with the whole pedestrian subway temporarily closed; and
 - (b) during the period from 18 April to 31 December 2017, with parts of the pedestrian subway temporarily closed; and
- (II) the temporary closure of the pedestrian subway connecting Olympic Garden and the junction of Argyle Street and Ma Tau Chung Road, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered SCL/G22/0062/1, with details as follows:
 - (a) during the period from 1 March to 17 April 2017, with parts of the pedestrian subway temporarily closed; and
 - (b) during the period from 18 April to 31 December 2017, with the whole pedestrian subway temporarily closed,

for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the pedestrian subways to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the pedestrian subways or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the pedestrian subways affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the pedestrian subways or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

Description of the works and the manner in which the pedestrian subways will be affected

(a) The pedestrian subway connecting Olympic Garden and the junction of Argyle Street and Prince Edward Road West, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G22/0062/1.
