SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF LOK SHAN ROAD; AND
PERMANENT ALTERATION OF SECTIONS OF
LOK SHAN ROAD AND KIANG SU STREET**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 2 December 2019 (the ‘Order’), authorized:–

- (I) the permanent closure of part of the carriageway widths of the section of Lok Shan Road between a point about 5 metres east of its junction with Maidstone Road and a point about 23 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0055/8; and
- (II) the permanent alteration of sections of Lok Shan Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Maidstone Road, and the section of Kiang Su Street between Ma Tau Wai Road and Maidstone Road, as delineated and shown in yellow and blue respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0055/8,

with effect from 31 December 2019 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0055/8 (the ‘Plan’) may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:–

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads affected by the Order on 13 December 2019.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing so as to reach the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the closure/alteration of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order. Claims can be submitted via one of the following means:—
