NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
PERMANENT CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF
THE PRIVATE ROAD BETWEEN OCEAN PARK ROAD AND
THE ENTRANCE OF THE OCEAN PARK; AND
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE OPEN PLACES ADJACENT TO
NAM LONG SHAN ROAD SITTING-OUT AREA AND
AN OPEN PLACE ADJACENT TO KWUN HOI PATH SITTING-OUT AREA

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 11 March 2016 (the 'Order'), authorized:-

- (I) the permanent closure of sections of the private road between Ocean Park Road and the entrance of the Ocean Park at the points about 5 metres, 25 metres and 40 metres north of the entry plaza of the Ocean Park, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SILE/G08/0010/6 with effect from 1 April 2016; and
- (II) (a) the temporary closure of the open place adjacent to Nam Long Shan Road Sitting-out Area (near Wong Chuk Hang Road), as delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered SILE/G09/0011/2;
 - (b) the temporary partial closure of the open place adjacent to Nam Long Shan Road Sitting-out Area (near Heung Yip Road), as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SILE/G09/0011/2; and
 - (c) the temporary closure of the open place adjacent to Kwun Hoi Path Sitting-out Area, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SILE/G10/0011/2,

during the period from 1 April to 30 June 2016,

for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the South Island Line (East). A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the road and the areas of the open places to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the road and the open places or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the road and the open places affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the open places or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

SCHEDULE

The road and the open places to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which the road and the open places will be affected

- (a) Sections of the private road between Ocean Park Road and the entrance of the Ocean Park at the points about 5 metres, 25 metres and 40 metres north of the entry plaza of the Ocean Park, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SILE/G08/0010/6.
- Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be permanently closed due to the construction of the footbridge of the South Island Line (East).
- (b) The open place adjacent to Nam Long Shan Road Sitting-out Area (near Wong Chuk Hang Road), as delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered SILF/G09/0011/2.
- The open place will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the footbridge and its associated structures of the South Island Line (East), and reinstatement works
- (c) The open place adjacent to Nam Long Shan Road Sitting-out Area (near Heung Yip Road), as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SILE/G09/0011/2.
- Part of the open place will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the footbridge and its associated structures of the South Island Line (East), and reinstatement works.
- (d) The open place adjacent to Kwun Hoi Path Sitting-out Area, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SILE/G10/0011/2.

The open place will be temporarily closed for the construction of a footbridge and its associated structures across Wong Chuk Hang Nullah to facilitate the construction of the South Island Line (East) and reinstatement works
