NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PARTS OF THE OPEN SPACE IN HARCOURT GARDEN; PARTS OF A FOOTBRIDGE AT HARCOURT GARDEN; SECTIONS OF HARCOURT ROAD, RODNEY STREET, DRAKE STREET AND QUEENSWAY; PARTS OF THE OPEN SPACE IN HONG KONG PARK AND A FOOTPATH ALONG SUPREME COURT ROAD ADJACENT TO HONG KONG PARK; AND SECTIONS OF SUPREME COURT ROAD AND JUSTICE DRIVE

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 17 May 2011 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary closure of parts of the open space in Harcourt Garden, as delineated and shown in orange on Plan numbered SILE/G01/0001/1;
- (II) the temporary closure of parts of a footbridge at Harcourt Garden connecting United Centre and CITIC Tower, as delineated and shown in purple on Plan numbered SILE/G01/0001/1;
- (III) the temporary partial closure of sections of Harcourt Road between a point about 120 metres west of its junction with Tim Mei Avenue and a point about 180 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in pink on Plan numbered SILE/G01/0001/1;
- (IV) the temporary partial closure of sections of Rodney Street; sections of Drake Street between its junction with Rodney Street and a point about 90 metres west of the junction; and sections of Queensway between its junction with Tamar Street and a point about 290 metres east of the junction with a footpath of about 45 metres long adjacent to Harcourt Garden, as delineated and shown in yellow, blue and green respectively on Plans numbered SILE/G01/0001/1 and SILE/G02/0001/1;
- (V) the temporary closure of parts of the open space in Hong Kong Park and a footpath along Supreme Court Road adjacent to Hong Kong Park, as delineated and shown in purple on Plan numbered SILE/G02/0001/1; and
- (VI) the temporary partial closure of sections of Supreme Court Road, and sections of Justice Drive between its junction with Supreme Court Road and a point about 50 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in pink and orange respectively on Plan numbered SILE/G02/0001/1,

during the period from 27 May 2011 to 26 May 2012 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the South Island Line (East). A description of the works to be carried out and the parts of the open spaces, the footbridge and the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the open spaces, the footbridge and the roads affected by the Order on 20 May 2011.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 15th Floor, Murray Building, Garden Road, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the open spaces, the footbridge and the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the open spaces, the footbridge and the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the open spaces, the footbridge and the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

SCHEDULE

The open spaces, the footbridge and the roads to be affected

- (a) Parts of the open space in Harcourt Garden, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered SILE/G01/0001/1.
- (b) Parts of a footbridge at Harcourt Garden connecting United Centre and CITIC Tower, as delineated and shown in purple on the Plan numbered SILE/G01/0001/1.
- (c) Sections of Harcourt Road between a point about 120 metres west of its junction with Tim Mei Avenue and a point about 180 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in pink on Plan numbered SILE/G01/0001/1.

Description of the works and the manner in which the open spaces, the footbridge and the roads will be affected

Parts of the open space will be temporarily closed for the demolition of existing railway facilities and parts of the footbridge at Harcourt Garden, and for the construction of the ventilation shafts and plant building, the emergency accesses, the railway tunnel, the railway station at Admiralty and the associated railway facilities of the South Island Line (East).

Parts of the footbridge deck, footbridge staircase and escalator will be temporarily closed and demolished for the construction of the ventilation shafts and plant building, the emergency accesses, the railway tunnel, the railway station at Admiralty and the associated railway facilities of the South Island Line (East).

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed in connection with the construction of the ventilation shafts and plant building, the railway tunnel, the railway station at Admiralty and the associated railway facilities of the South Island Line (East). The open spaces, the footbridge and the roads to be affected

- (d) Sections of Rodney Street; sections of Drake Street between its junction with Rodney Street and a point about 90 metres west of the junction; and sections of Queensway between its junction with Tamar Street and a point about 290 metres east of the junction with a footpath of about 45 metres long adjacent to Harcourt Garden, as delineated and shown in yellow, blue and green respectively on the Plans numbered SILE/G01/0001/1 and SILE/G02/0001/1.
- (e) Parts of the open space in Hong Kong Park and a footpath along Supreme Court Road adjacent to Hong Kong Park, as delineated and shown in purple on the Plan numbered SILE/G02/0001/1.
- (f) Sections of Supreme Court Road; and sections of Justice Drive between its junction with Supreme Court Road and a point about 50 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in pink and orange respectively on the Plan numbered SILE/G02/0001/1.

Description of the works and the manner in which the open spaces, the footbridge and the roads will be affected

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed in connection with the construction of the ventilation shafts and plant building, the railway tunnel, the railway station at Admiralty and the associated railway facilities of the South Island Line (East).

The footpath and parts of the open space will be temporarily closed for the modification of the existing substation and demolition of the existing refuse collection point for the construction of the ventilation and plant building and the associated railway facilities of the South Island Line (East).

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the ventilation and plant building, the railway tunnel and the associated railway facilities of the South Island Line (East).

Statement on Personal Data
