SOUTH ISLAND LINE (EAST)

NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF NAM FUNG ROAD,
WONG CHUK HANG PATH, NAM FUNG PATH AND TIN WAN PRAYA ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 8 May 2012 (the ‘Order’), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary partial closure of sections of Nam Fung Road between its junction with Wong Chuk Hang Road and Nam Fung Road Rest Garden, sections of Wong Chuk Hang Path, and sections of Nam Fung Path between its junction with Nam Fung Road and the roundabout near St. Paul’s Co-educational College Primary School; and
- (II) the temporary partial closure of sections of Tin Wan Praya Road between its junction with Wah Kwai Road and a point about 130 metres east of the junction,

during the period from 27 May 2012 to 26 May 2013 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the South Island Line (East). A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered SILE/G07/0002/1 and SILE/G08/0002/1 delineating and showing in yellow, blue and green respectively the sections of the roads affected by (I); and the Plan numbered SILE/G14/0002/01 delineating and showing in yellow the sections of the road affected by (II) may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

Copies of the Order and the Plans numbered SILE/G07/0002/1, SILE/G08/0002/1 and SILE/G14/0002/1 (the ‘Plans’) may be purchased from the Railway Development Office of the Highways Department. A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads affected by the Order on 11 May 2012.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

(a) Sections of Nam Fung Road between its junction with Wong Chuk Hang Road and Nam Fung Road Rest Garden, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plans numbered SILE/G07/0002/1 and SILE/G08/0002/1.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the railway tunnel, ventilation and plant building, and the associated railway facilities of the South Island Line (East).
(b) Sections of Wong Chuk Hang Path, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plans numbered SILE/G07/0002/1 and SILE/G08/0002/1.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed in connection with the construction of the railway tunnel, railway viaduct and the associated railway facilities of the South Island Line (East).
(c) Sections of Nam Fung Path between its junction with Nam Fung Road and the roundabout near St. Paul's Co-educational College Primary School, as delineated and shown in green on the Plans numbered SILE/G07/0002/1 and SILE/G08/0002/1.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the railway tunnel, railway viaduct and the associated railway facilities of the South Island Line (East).
(d) Sections of Tin Wan Praya Road between its junction with Wah Kwai Road and a point about 130 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SILE/G14/0002/1.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed in connection with the works at the temporary works area for the South Island Line (East).

Statement on Personal Data
