AUTHORIZATION FOR TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF A FOOTPATH NEAR TAI WONG YE TEMPLE AND A FOOTPATH AND STAIRCASE NEAR HOLY SPIRIT SEMINARY AT WONG CHUK HANG

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize –

- (I) the temporary closure of the section of the footpath between its junction with the western end of Tai Wong Ye Temple and a point about 90 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SILE/G09/0006/2; and
- (II) the temporary closure of the footpath and staircase connecting Holy Spirit Seminary to the southern side of Wong Chuk Hang Nullah, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SILE/G10/0006/2,

during the period from 24 June 2013 to 23 June 2014. I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the footpaths and staircase as described above during the period from 24 June 2013 to 23 June 2014 shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
