## NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF SOUTH HORIZON DRIVE, YI NAM ROAD AND LEI TUNG ESTATE ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 5 June 2015 (the 'Order'), authorized:-

- (I) the temporary closure of the section of South Horizon Drive between a point about 20 metres west of its junction with Yi Nam Road and a point about 70 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SILE/G13/0007/4;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the section of Yi Nam Road between its junction with South Horizon Drive and a point about 40 metres southeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SILE/G13/0007/4; and
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the section of Lei Tung Estate Road adjacent to Lei Tung Commercial Centre (Phase 1), as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan numbered SILE/G11/0008/4.

during the period from 1 July 2015 to 30 June 2016 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the South Island Line (East). A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.
