**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
THE WORKS OVER AND UPON THE GOVERNMENT FORESHORE AND
SEA-BED AT TELEGRAPH BAY OFF CYBERPORT ROAD**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 5 September 2014 (the 'Order'), authorized the works over and upon the Government foreshore and sea-bed at Telegraph Bay off Cyberport Road, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SILE/G17/0009/1 during the period from 1 October 2014 to 30 June 2015 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the South Island Line (East). A description of the works to be carried out, the area of the Government foreshore and sea-bed to be affected and the manner in which it will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the date of extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the Government foreshore and sea-bed affected by the Order.

An area of the Government foreshore and sea-bed at Telegraph Bay off Cyberport Road, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan.

The works involve the use of the existing temporary barge loading facilities (including the existing temporary pier), which is located at the west of the Cyberport Sewage Treatment Plant, the demolition of the pier and the reinstatement of the Government foreshore and sea-bed.
