**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A FOOTPATH ADJACENT TO
AP LEI CHAU MAIN STREET TEMPORARY SITTING-OUT AREA, AND
SECTIONS OF LEI TUNG ESTATE ROAD, AP LEI CHAU BRIDGE ROAD,
LEE NAM ROAD, YI NAM ROAD AND SOUTH HORIZON DRIVE**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 14 December 2016 (the ‘Order’), authorized:-

- (I) the temporary partial closure of the footpath adjacent to Ap Lei Chau Main Street Temporary Sitting-out Area, as delineated and shown in light blue on the Plan numbered SILE/G11/0004/6;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the section of Lei Tung Estate Road adjacent to the Lei Tung Commercial Centre (Phase 1), Tung Sing House and Tung Hing House, as delineated and shown in brown on the Plans numbered SILE/G11/0004/6 and SILE/G12/0004/6; and
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the section of Ap Lei Chau Bridge Road between its junction with Lee Nam Road and a point about 60 metres west of its junction with Yi Nam Road, the section of Lee Nam Road between its junction with Ap Lei Chau Bridge Road and a point about 220 metres southwest of its junction with Yi Nam Road, the section of Yi Nam Road between Lee Nam Road and Ap Lei Chau Bridge Road, and the section of South Horizon Drive between its junction with Yi Nam Road and a point about 20 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow, light blue, dark purple and orange respectively on the Plan numbered SILE/G13/0004/6,

during the period from 1 January to 30 June 2017 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the South Island Line (East). A description of the works to be carried out, the footpath and the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered SILE/G11/0004/6, SILE/G12/0004/6 and SILE/G13/0004/6 (the ‘Plans’) may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:-

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the footpath and the roads affected by the Order on 23 December 2016.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the footpath and the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the footpath and the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the footpath and the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.
