

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)  
(Notice under section 23)**

**SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK**

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING  
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF  
SECTIONS OF SAI SHA ROAD, ON YUEN STREET, ON LUK STREET,  
MA ON SHAN BYPASS, A SLIP ROAD FROM SAI SHA ROAD TO  
LOK WO SHA LANE AND A FOOTPATH NEAR MTR WU KAI SHA STATION**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 2 February 2015 (the ‘Order’), authorized:–

- (I) the temporary partial closure of the section of Sai Sha Road between a point about 150 metres southwest of its junction with On Luk Street and a point about 275 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered SCL/G45/0033/2;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the section of On Yuen Street between its junction with Sai Sha Road and a point about 45 metres north of the junction, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SCL/G45/0033/2;
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the section of On Luk Street between its junction with Sai Sha Road and a point about 60 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G45/0033/2;
- (IV) the temporary partial closure of the section of Sai Sha Road (and its adjacent footpaths and pedestrian subway) between the footbridge near MTR Wu Kai Sha Station and a point about 140 metres east of its junction with its slip road to Lok Wo Sha Lane, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered SCL/G46/0018/3;
- (V) the temporary partial closure of the section of Ma On Shan Bypass between its junction with Sai Sha Road (near MTR Wu Kai Sha Station) and a point about 90 metres southeast of the junction, and the section of Ma On Shan Bypass between its junction with Sai Sha Road (near lamp post BE 1562) and a point about 90 metres southeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SCL/G46/0018/3;
- (VI) the temporary partial closure of the section of the slip road from Sai Sha Road to Lok Wo Sha Lane, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G46/0018/3; and

- (VII) the temporary closure of the section of the footpath near MTR Wu Kai Sha Station, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SCL/G46/0018/3,

during the period from 1 March 2015 to 29 February 2016, for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads, or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.
