NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF WAN WAH STREET; AND TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A STAIRCASE AND FOOTPATH CONNECTING CHOI HUNG ROAD AND LUNG CHEUNG ROAD, AND A SECTION OF LUNG CHEUNG ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 7 March 2018 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the permanent closure of part of the footpath widths of the section of Wan Wah Street at its junction with Sheung Fung Street, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/13 with effect from 1 April 2018;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the staircase and footpath connecting Choi Hung Road and Lung Cheung Road (near Entrance A2 of the MTR Diamond Hill Station), as delineated and shown in dark purple on the Plan numbered SCL/G11/0016/7 during the period from 19 April to 30 September 2018; and
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the section of Lung Cheung Road between its junction with Tai Hom Road near Lung Poon Court and a point about 830 metres southeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in green on the Plans numbered SCL/G11/0016/7 and SCL/G12/0016/6 during the period from 19 April to 31 December 2018,

for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads, the staircase and the footpath to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing so as to reach the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads, the staircase and the footpath or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads, the staircase and the footpath affected by the Order. Claims can be submitted via one of the following means:-

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads, the staircase and the footpath or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

The roads, the staircase and the footpath to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which the roads, the staircase and the footpath will be affected

(a) Part of the footpath widths of the section of Wan Wah Street at its junction with Sheung Fung Street, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G10/0009/13. Part of the footpath widths will be permanently closed for the provision of the pedestrian walkway system in relation to the Shatin to Central Link. The roads, the staircase and the footpath to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which the roads, the staircase and the footpath will be affected

- (b) The staircase and footpath connecting Choi Hung Road and Lung Cheung Road (near Entrance A2 of the MTR Diamond Hill Station), as delineated and shown in dark purple on the Plan numbered SCL/G11/0016/7.
- Parts of the staircase and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link, the extension of the MTR Diamond Hill Station, and reinstatement works.
- (c) The section of Lung Cheung Road between its junction with Tai Hom Road near Lung Poon Court and a point about 830 metres southeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in green on the Plans numbered SCL/G11/0016/7 and SCL/G12/0016/6.

Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link, the extension of the MTR Diamond Hill Station, and reinstatement works
