## RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519) (Order under section 22(1))

## SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK

## AUTHORIZATION FOR TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF HARBOUR ROAD; AND TEMPORARY ALTERATION OF SECTIONS OF TONNOCHY ROAD, HUNG HING ROAD, FLEMING ROAD, EXPO DRIVE EAST, EXPO DRIVE CENTRAL AND CONVENTION AVENUE

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize:—

- (I) the temporary partial closure of the section of Harbour Road between its junction with Tonnochy Road and a point about 70 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in red on the Plans numbered SCL/G34/0054/1 and SCL/G35/0054/2;
- (II) the temporary alteration of the section of Tonnochy Road between its junction with Hung Hing Road and its junction with Harbour Road, and the section of Hung Hing Road between its junction with Convention Avenue and its junction with Marsh Road, as delineated and shown in orange and yellow respectively on the Plans numbered SCL/G34/0054/1 and SCL/G35/0054/2; and
- (III) the temporary alteration of the section of Fleming Road between its junction with Harbour Road and its junction with Convention Avenue, the section of Expo Drive East between its junction with Convention Avenue and a point about 180 metres north of the junction, the section of Expo Drive Central between its junction with Expo Drive East and a point about 35 metres west of the junction, and the section of Convention Avenue between its junction with Hung Hing Road and a point about 200 metres west of its junction with Expo Drive East, as delineated and shown in green, blue, brown and purple respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G35/0054/2,

during the period from 1 May 2017 to 30 April 2018. I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that during the period from 1 May 2017 to 30 April 2018, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the roads as described above shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
