**AUTHORIZATION FOR
PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF A ROAD CONNECTING
EX-NEW TERRITORIES SOUTH ANIMAL MANAGEMENT CENTER AND
CHE KUNG MIU ROAD, AND PART OF HIN TIN PLAYGROUND; AND
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF CHE KUNG MIU ROAD,
HIN KENG STREET AND A ROAD CONNECTING EX-NEW TERRITORIES
SOUTH ANIMAL MANAGEMENT CENTER AND CHE KUNG MIU ROAD**

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize:-

- (I) the permanent closure of part of the carriageway and footpath widths of the section of the road connecting ex-New Territories South Animal Management Center and Che Kung Miu Road, as delineated and shown in purple on the Plan numbered SCL/G03/0037/4 with effect from 16 May 2018;
- (II) the permanent closure of part of Hin Tin Playground, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G03/0037/4 with effect from 15 July 2018; and
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the section of Che Kung Miu Road between a point about 215 metres northeast of its junction with Hin Keng Street and a point about 60 metres southwest of the junction, the section of Hin Keng Street between its junction with Che Kung Miu Road and a point about 60 metres southeast of the junction, and the section of the road connecting ex-New Territories South Animal Management Center and Che Kung Miu Road, as delineated and shown in red, yellow and beige respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G03/0037/4 during the period from 16 May to 15 August 2018.

I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that all public or private rights in, upon, under or over (i) the section of the road as described in (I) above with effect from 16 May 2018; (ii) the part of Hin Tin Playground as described in (II) above with effect from 15 July 2018; and (iii) the sections of the roads as described in (III) above during the period from 16 May to 15 August 2018, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
