

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)**  
**(Order under section 22(1))**

**SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK**

**AUTHORIZATION FOR  
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF MA CHAI HANG ROAD,  
PARTS OF MA CHAI HANG RECREATION GROUND, AND PART OF THE  
FOOTBRIDGE AT MA CHAI HANG ROAD**

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Logistics, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize:—

- (I) (a) the temporary partial closure of the section of Ma Chai Hang Road between a point about 5 metres northwest of its junction with Lung Cheung Road and a point about 24 metres northwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered SCL/G07/0013/1;
- (b) the temporary closure of part of Ma Chai Hang Recreation Ground, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G07/0013/1; and
- (c) the temporary closure of part of the footbridge at Ma Chai Hang Road, as delineated and shown in brown on the Plan numbered SCL/G07/0013/1,

during the period from 13 September 2022 to 12 September 2023; and

- (II) (a) the temporary partial closure of the section of Ma Chai Hang Road between a point about 10 metres south of its junction with Chuk Yuen Road and a point about 160 metres southeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered SCL/G07/0013/1; and
- (b) the temporary closure of part of Ma Chai Hang Recreation Ground, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SCL/G07/0013/1,

during the period from 1 October 2022 to 12 September 2023.

I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that all public or private rights in, upon, under or over (i) the section of the road, the part of Ma Chai Hang Recreation Ground and part of the footbridge at Ma Chai Hang Road as described in (I) above during the period from 13 September 2022 to 12 September 2023; and (ii) the section of the road and the part of Ma Chai Hang Recreation Ground as described in (II) above during the period from

1 October 2022 to 12 September 2023, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
