SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK

AUTHORIZATION FOR TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF OLYMPIC AVENUE, SUNG WONG TOI ROAD, NAM KOK ROAD, NGA TSIN WAI ROAD AND PRINCE EDWARD ROAD WEST

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize:-

- (I) (a) the temporary partial closure of the section of Olympic Avenue between Dakota Drive and Hang Wan Road, as delineated and shown in beige on the Plans numbered SCL/G19/0010/3 and SCL/G22/0010/3, and
 - (b) the temporary partial closure of the section of Sung Wong Toi Road between Hang Wan Road and a point about 60 metres southeast of its junction with Pak Tai Street, and the section of Sung Wong Toi Road between Ma Tau Chung Road and a point about 60 metres southeast of its junction with Pak Tai Street, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plans numbered SCL/G19/0010/3 and SCL/G22/0010/3,

during the period from 1 February 2015 to 31 January 2016; and

(II) the temporary partial closure of the section of Nam Kok Road between Prince Edward Road West and a point about 50 metres north of its junction with Nga Tsin Wai Road, the section of Nga Tsin Wai Road between Lung Kong Road and Nga Tsin Long Road, and the section of Prince Edward Road West between a point about 5 metres east of its junction with Nam Kok Road and a point about 20 metres west of the junction, as delineated and shown in red, orange and pink respectively on the Plans numbered SCL/G18/0013/3 and SCL/G21/0013/3 during the period from 15 March 2015 to 31 January 2016.

I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the roads as described in (I) above during the period from 1 February 2015 to 31 January 2016; and the sections of the roads as described in (II) above during the period from 15 March 2015 to 31 January 2016, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
