# NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING THE WORKS OVER AND UPON THE GOVERNMENT FORESHORE AND SEA-BED AT KOWLOON BAY OFF THE FORMER KAI TAK AIRPORT RUNWAY

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 20 July 2012 (the 'Order'), authorized the works over and upon the Government foreshore and sea-bed at Kowloon Bay off the former Kai Tak Airport runway during the period from 13 August 2012 to 12 August 2013 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the area of the foreshore and sea-bed to be affected and the manner in which it will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plan numbered SCL/G17/0001/1 (the 'Plan') delineating and showing the Government foreshore and sea-bed affected in red, may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public: -

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the date of extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the Government foreshore and sea-bed affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further works over and upon the same part or parts of the Government foreshore and sea-bed or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for works will be published if and when such an order is made.

An area of Kowloon Bay off the former Kai Tak Airport runway at its western side, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G17/0001/1.	The works involve dredging works and operation of temporary barge loading facilities and temporary barge mooring area, where parts of the facilities will be extended to over and upon the foreshore and sea-bed (above sea level), so as to facilitate the construction of the railway

works of the Shatin to Central Link.
