NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING  
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF  
PAU CHUNG STREET, LOK SHAN ROAD, KOWLOON CITY ROAD,  
MA TAU WAI ROAD, TAM KUNG ROAD, SHEUNG HEUNG ROAD,  
MAIDSTONE ROAD, KIANG SU STREET, CHI KIANG STREET,  
TO KWA WAN ROAD, CHATHAM ROAD NORTH, TIN KWONG ROAD,  
SHEUNG SHING STREET AND KAU PUI LUNG ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 13 August 2019 (the 'Order'), authorized:-

- (I) (a) the temporary partial closure of the section of Pau Chung Street between Sheung Heung Road and Lok Shan Road, as delineated and shown in dark grey on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/7 and SCL/G24/0004/8;
- (b) the temporary partial closure of the section of Lok Shan Road between Pau Chung Street and Kowloon City Road, and the section of Lok Shan Road between its junction with Kowloon City Road and a point about 25 metres southeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in light green on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/8; and
- (c) the temporary partial closure of the section of Kowloon City Road between a point about 30 metres northeast of its junction with Lok Shan Road and a point about 30 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark brown on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/8,

during the period from 1 September to 31 December 2019;

- (II) (a) the temporary partial closure of the section of Ma Tau Wai Road (and two adjacent footpaths) between a point about 50 metres north of its junction with San Shan Road and a point about 50 metres south of its junction with To Kwa Wan Road, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/7, SCL/G24/0004/8 and SCL/G25/0004/6;
- (b) the temporary partial closure of the section of Tam Kung Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and San Shan Road, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G23/0004/7;

- (c) the temporary partial closure of the section of Sheung Heung Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Pau Chung Street, as delineated and shown in light purple on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/7 and SCL/G24/0004/8;
- (d) the temporary partial closure of the section of Maidstone Road between a point about 40 metres north of its junction with Lok Shan Road and a point about 40 metres south of the junction, and the section of Maidstone Road between a point about 40 metres north of its junction with Kiang Su Street and a point about 40 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark green on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/8;
- (e) the temporary partial closure of the section of Lok Shan Road between Maidstone Road and Kau Pui Lung Road, the section of Kowloon City Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Sze Chuen Street, and the section of Kiang Su Street between Maidstone Road and Kau Pui Lung Road, as delineated and shown in dark blue, dark purple and red respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/8;
- (f) the temporary partial closure of the section of Chi Kiang Street between Ma Tau Wai Road and Ko Shan Road, and the section of Chi Kiang Street between Ma Tau Wai Road and To Kwa Wan Road, as delineated and shown in beige on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/8; and
- (g) the temporary partial closure of the section of To Kwa Wan Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Chi Kiang Street, and the section of Chatham Road North between its junction with Ma Tau Wai Road and a point about 30 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in pink and light blue respectively on the Plans numbered SCL/G24/0004/8 and SCL/G25/0004/6,

during the period from 1 September 2019 to 31 March 2020; and

- (III) (a) the temporary partial closure of the section of Tin Kwong Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and a point about 30 metres northwest of its junction with Farm Road, and the section of Sheung Shing Street between its junction with Tin Kwong Road and a point about 20 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in pink and olive respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G23/0004/7; and
- (b) the temporary partial closure of the section of Kau Pui Lung Road between its junction with Tin Kwong Road and a point about 160 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/7 and SCL/G24/0004/8,

during the period from 1 September 2019 to 30 June 2020,

for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/7, SCL/G24/0004/8 and SCL/G25/0004/6 (the 'Plans') may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:–

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads affected by the Order on 23 August 2019.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing so as to reach the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order. Claims can be submitted via one of the following means:–

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

(a) The section of Pau Chung Street between Sheung Heung Road and Lok Shan Road, as delineated and shown in dark grey on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/7 and SCL/G24/0004/8.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
(b) The section of Lok Shan Road between Pau Chung Street and Kowloon City Road, and the section of Lok Shan Road between its junction with Kowloon City Road and a point about 25 metres southeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in light green on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/8.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
(c) The section of Kowloon City Road between a point about 30 metres northeast of its junction with Lok Shan Road and a point about 30 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark brown on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/8.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
(d) The section of Ma Tau Wai Road (and two adjacent footpaths) between a point about 50 metres north of its junction with San Shan Road and a point about 50 metres south of its junction with To Kwa Wan Road, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/7, SCL/G24/0004/8 and SCL/G25/0004/6.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.

(e) The section of Tam Kung Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and San Shan Road, as delineated and shown in red on the Plan numbered SCL/G23/0004/7.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
(f) The section of Sheung Heung Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Pau Chung Street, as delineated and shown in light purple on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/7 and SCL/G24/0004/8.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
(g) The section of Maidstone Road between a point about 40 metres north of its junction with Lok Shan Road and a point about 40 metres south of the junction, and the section of Maidstone Road between a point about 40 metres north of its junction with Kiang Su Street and a point about 40 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark green on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/8.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
(h) The section of Lok Shan Road between Maidstone Road and Kau Pui Lung Road, the section of Kowloon City Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Sze Chuen Street, and the section of Kiang Su Street between Maidstone Road and Kau Pui Lung Road, as delineated and shown in dark blue, dark purple and red respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/8.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
(i) The section of Chi Kiang Street between Ma Tau Wai Road and Ko Shan Road, and the section of Chi Kiang Street between Ma Tau Wai Road and To Kwa Wan Road, as delineated and shown in beige on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/8.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.

(j) The section of To Kwa Wan Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Chi Kiang Street, and the section of Chatham Road North between its junction with Ma Tau Wai Road and a point about 30 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in pink and light blue respectively on the Plans numbered SCL/G24/0004/8 and SCL/G25/0004/6.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
(k) The section of Tin Kwong Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and a point about 30 metres northwest of its junction with Farm Road, and the section of Sheung Shing Street between its junction with Tin Kwong Road and a point about 20 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in pink and olive respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G23/0004/7.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
(l) The section of Kau Pui Lung Road between its junction with Tin Kwong Road and a point about 160 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/7 and SCL/G24/0004/8.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.
