**SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK**

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING  
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF  
THE OPEN SPACE IN WINSLOW STREET PLAYGROUND,  
THE OPEN SPACE NEAR CHATHAM ROAD NORTH AND ITS LINK ROAD,  
THE OPEN SPACE NEAR OI SEN PATH AND CHATHAM ROAD NORTH, AND  
THE STAIRCASE CONNECTING CHATHAM ROAD NORTH AND  
WINSLOW STREET PLAYGROUND**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 1 December 2014 (the ‘Order’), authorized:-

- (I) the temporary closure of the open space in Winslow Street Playground, the open space near Chatham Road North and its link road, and the open space near Oi Sen Path and Chatham Road North, as delineated and shown in red, blue and green respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G27/0006/3; and
- (II) the temporary closure of the staircase connecting Chatham Road North and Winslow Street Playground, as delineated and shown in purple on the Plan numbered SCL/G27/0006/3,

during the period from 21 December 2014 to 20 December 2015 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the open spaces and the staircase to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plan numbered SCL/G27/0006/3 (the ‘Plan’) may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:-

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the open spaces and the staircase affected by the Order on 5 December 2014.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the open spaces and the staircase or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the open spaces and the staircase affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the open spaces and the staircase or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.
