NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF SAN SHAN ROAD, MA TAU WAI ROAD, TAM KUNG ROAD, TIN KWONG ROAD, SHEUNG SHING STREET, KAU PUI LUNG ROAD, SHEUNG HEUNG ROAD, PAU CHUNG STREET, MAIDSTONE ROAD, LOK SHAN ROAD, KOWLOON CITY ROAD, KIANG SU STREET, HA HEUNG ROAD, CHI KIANG STREET, TO KWA WAN ROAD AND CHATHAM ROAD NORTH

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 3 October 2018 (the 'Order'), authorized:-

- (I) the temporary closure of the section of San Shan Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Tam Kung Road, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SCL/G23/0004/6, with details as follows:
 - (a) during the period from 22 October to 6 December 2018, with all carriageway and parts of the footpath widths of the section of the road temporarily closed; and
 - (b) during the period from 7 December 2018 to 31 August 2019, with parts of the carriageway and footpath widths of the section of the road temporarily closed; and
- (II) (a) the temporary partial closure of the section of Ma Tau Wai Road (and two adjacent footpaths) between a point about 50 metres north of its junction with San Shan Road and a point about 50 metres south of its junction with To Kwa Wan Road, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/6, SCL/G24/0004/7 and SCL/G25/0004/6;
 - (b) the temporary partial closure of the section of San Shan Road between Tam Kung Road and Pak Tai Street, the section of Tam Kung Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Ma Tau Kok Road, the section of Tin Kwong Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and a point about 30 metres northwest of the junction of Tin Kwong Road and Farm Road, and the section of Sheung Shing Street between its junction with Tin Kwong Road and a point about 20 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark blue, red, pink and olive respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G23/0004/6;

- (c) the temporary partial closure of the section of Kau Pui Lung Road between its junction with Tin Kwong Road and a point about 160 metres south of the junction, the section of Sheung Heung Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Pau Chung Street, and the section of Pau Chung Street between Sheung Heung Road and Lok Shan Road, as delineated and shown in yellow, light purple and grey respectively on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/6 and SCL/G24/0004/7;
- (d) the temporary partial closure of the section of Maidstone Road between a point about 40 metres north of its junction with Lok Shan Road and a point about 40 metres south of the junction, and the section of Maidstone Road between a point about 40 metres north of its junction with Kiang Su Street and a point about 40 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark green on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/7;
- (e) the temporary partial closure of the section of Lok Shan Road between Maidstone Road and Kau Pui Lung Road, and the section of Lok Shan Road between Pau Chung Street and a point about 25 metres southeast of its junction with Kowloon City Road, as delineated and shown in dark blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/7;
- (f) the temporary partial closure of the section of Kowloon City Road between a point about 30 metres northeast of its junction with Lok Shan Road and a point about 30 metres southwest of the junction, and the section of Kowloon City Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Sze Chuen Street, as delineated and shown in dark purple on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/7;
- (g) the temporary partial closure of the section of Kiang Su Street between Maidstone Road and Kau Pui Lung Road, and the section of Ha Heung Road between its junction with Chi Kiang Street and a point about 15 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in red and brown respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/7;
- (h) the temporary partial closure of the section of Chi Kiang Street between Ma Tau Wai Road and Ko Shan Road, and the section of Chi Kiang Street between Ma Tau Wai Road and To Kwa Wan Road, as delineated and shown in beige on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/7; and
- (i) the temporary partial closure of the section of To Kwa Wan Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Lok Shan Road, and the section of Chatham Road North between its junction with Ma Tau Wai Road and a point about 30 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in pink and light blue respectively on the Plans numbered SCL/G24/0004/7 and SCL/G25/0004/6,

during the period from 22 October 2018 to 31 August 2019,

for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing so as to reach the Secretary for Transport and Housing before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order. Claims can be submitted via one of the following means: –

(a) The section of San Shan Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Tam Kung Road, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SCL/G23/0004/6. During the period from 22 October to 6 December 2018, all carriageway and parts of the footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway station and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link, and reinstatement works.

During the period from 7 December 2018 to 31 August 2019, parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway station and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link, and reinstatement works.

(b) The section of Ma Tau Wai Road (and two adjacent footpaths) between a point about 50 metres north of its junction with San Shan Road and a point about 50 metres south of its junction with To Kwa Wan Road, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/6, SCL/G24/0004/7 and SCL/G25/0004/6. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway station and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link, and reinstatement works. - (c) The section of San Shan Road between Tam Kung Road and Pak Tai Street, the section of Tam Kung Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Ma Tau Kok Road, the section of Tin Kwong Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and a point about 30 metres northwest of the junction of Tin Kwong Road and Farm Road, and the section of Sheung Shing Street between its junction with Tin Kwong Road and a point about 20 metres southwest of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark blue, red, pink and olive respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G23/0004/6.
- (d) The section of Kau Pui Lung Road between its junction with Tin Kwong Road and a point about 160 metres south of the junction, and the section of Sheung Heung Road between Ma Tau Wai Road and Pau Chung Street, as delineated and shown in yellow and light purple respectively on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/6 and SCL/G24/0004/7.
- (e) The section of Pau Chung Street between Sheung Heung Road and Lok Shan Road, as delineated and shown in grey on the Plans numbered SCL/G23/0004/6 and SCL/G24/0004/7.
- (f) The section of Maidstone Road between a point about 40 metres north of its junction with Lok Shan Road and a point about 40 metres south of the junction, and the section of Maidstone Road between a point about 40 metres north of its junction with Kiang Su Street and a point about 40 metres south of the junction, as delineated and shown in dark green on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/7.

- (i) The section of Kiang Su Street between Maidstone Road and Kau Pui Lung Road, and the section of Ha Heung Road between its junction with Chi Kiang Street and a point about 15 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in red and brown respectively on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/7.
- (j) The section of Chi Kiang Street between Ma Tau Wai Road and Ko Shan Road, and the section of Chi Kiang Street between Ma Tau Wai Road and To Kwa Wan Road, as delineated and shown in beige on the Plan numbered SCL/G24/0004/7.
