SHATIN TO CENTRAL LINK

AUTHORIZATION FOR PERMANENT CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF SAI SHA ROAD

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize:–

- (I) the permanent closure of part of the carriageway of the section of Sai Sha Road at a point about 50 metres west of its junction with Ma On Shan Bypass (near lamp post BE 1562), and part of the carriageway of the section of Sai Sha Road at a point about 70 metres west of its junction with Ma On Shan Bypass (near lamp post BE 1562), both delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered SCL/G46/0018/4; and
- (II) the permanent closure of part of the footpath of the section of Sai Sha Road at a point about 40 metres west of its junction with its slip road to Lok Wo Sha Lane, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SCL/G46/0018/4,

with effect from 1 March 2016. I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that with effect from 1 March 2016, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the road as described above shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
