NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LUEN YEE ROAD, CHOLHUNG ROAD ROUNDAROUT AND A SECTION OF HAMMER HILL ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 28 January 2014 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- the temporary partial closure of Luen Yee Road, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan numbered SCL/G11/0034/1:
- (II) the temporary partial closure of Choi Hung Road Roundabout, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plans numbered SCL/G11/0034/1 and SCL/G12/0034/1;
 and
- (III) the temporary partial closure of a section of Hammer Hill Road between its junction with Choi Hung Road Roundabout and a point about 100 metres northeast of the junction, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SCL/G12/0034/1,

during the period from 28 February 2014 to 27 February 2015 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Shatin to Central Link. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

(b) Choi Hung Road Roundabout, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plans numbered SCL/G11/0034/1 and SCL/G12/0034/1. Parts of the carriageway widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway tunnel at Kai Tak and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.

(c) A section of Hammer Hill Road between its junction with Choi Hung Road Roundabout and a point about 100 metres northeast of junction, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered SCL/G12/0034/1. Parts of the carriageway widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the construction of the railway tunnel at Kai Tak and the associated railway facilities of the Shatin to Central Link.
