NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING PERMANENT CLOSURE OF
A SECTION OF AUSTIN ROAD WEST

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 12 October 2010 (the 'Order'), authorized the permanent closure of a section of Austin Road West between Lin Cheung Road and Wui Man Road with effect from 4 November 2010 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the Hong Kong Section of Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link. A description of the works to be carried out and the area of the road to be affected and the manner in which it will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plan numbered XRL/G45/0003/1 (the 'Plan') delineating and showing the section of the road affected in red, may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 15th Floor, Murray Building, Garden Road, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the road or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the road affected by the Order.
