

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

(Notice under section 8(2))

PWP ITEM NO. 6806TH
DUALLING OF HIRAM'S HIGHWAY
FROM MARINA COVE TO SAI KUNG TOWN

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Acting Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 91272/GAZ/1000 to 91272/GAZ/1007 (the 'Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) widening of two sections of Hiram's Highway of approximately 3.5 kilometres long between Marina Cove and Pak Sha Wan, and between Pak Sha Wan and Sai Kung Town to a dual two-lane carriageway;
- (ii) widening of the Pak Sha Wan section of Hiram's Highway of approximately 100 metres long to a single four-lane carriageway;
- (iii) widening of a section of Po Tung Road of approximately 400 metres long between Yau Ma Po Street and Fuk Man Road to a dual two-lane carriageway;
- (iv) improvement of a section of Po Tung Road and Tai Mong Tsai Road of approximately 600 metres long between Fuk Man Road and Wai Man Road to a single two-lane carriageway up to current standard;
- (v) construction of carriageways, footpaths, central medians/refuge islands and amenity areas;
- (vi) construction of a subway across Hiram's Highway with associated lifts at Pak Sha Wan;
- (vii) permanent closure and demolition of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, central medians/refuge islands and amenity areas;
- (viii) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas; and
- (ix) ancillary works including landscaping, drainage, lightings, slope improvement, electrical and mechanical works; implementation of environmental mitigation measures; and provision of noise barriers, traffic aids and retaining walls.

The objector should describe his interest and the manner in which he alleges that he will be affected by the works or the use in his notice of objection. Objectors are requested to provide contact details to facilitate communication. A notice of objection should be delivered to the Secretary for Transport and Housing not later than 3rd day of March 2020.

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written objections/comments will be used for the processing of the objections/comments and other related purposes. The provision of any information, including the personal data, other than the information as required under section 10(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is voluntary. However, it may not be possible to process the objections/comments if such information, including the personal data, is not sufficiently provided. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other persons, organizations or agencies which are required to handle the objections/comments and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us.
