Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) Scheme annexed to Plan Nos. WD6820TH-GZ0001 to WD6820TH-GZ0009 under section 5 describing

PWP Item No. 6820TH Upgrading of Remaining Sections of Kam Tin Road and Lam Kam Road

General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ("the Ordinance"), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan Nos. WD6820TH-GZ0001 to WD6820TH-GZ0009 ("the Plans") annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed road works are required to upgrade the section of Kam Tin Road between Tung Wui Road and Lam Kam Road and the section of Lam Kam Road between Kam Tin Road and Kadoorie Farm and Botanic Garden for enhancement of road safety.

- 2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows
 - upgrading of a section of Kam Tin Road of approximately 1.9 kilometres long between Tung Wui Road and Fan Kam Road to a 10.3 metres wide single two-lane carriageway;
 - (ii) upgrading of a section of Kam Tin Road of approximately 2.1 kilometres long between Fan Kam Road and Lam Kam Road and a section of Lam Kam Road of approximately 1.3 kilometres long between Kam Tin Road and Kadoorie Farm and Botanic Garden to a 7.3 metres wide single two-lane carriageway;
 - (iii) construction of carriageways and footpaths;

- (iv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths, amenity areas and noise barrier;
- (v) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into carriageways and noise barrier;
- (vi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing amenity areas into carriageway and footpath;
- (vii) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and amenity area; and
- (viii) ancillary works including landscaping, drainage, slope improvement and street lighting works, implementation of environmental mitigation measures, installation of street furniture and traffic aids, noise barriers and retaining walls, and reprovisioning of affected structures/facilities, etc.

Land to be Resumed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 13 of the Ordinance may be exercised to resume the land as shown on Resumption Plan No. YLM10621 (Sheet 1 to 2) annexed hereto and detailed in the table set out thereon. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the land is to be resumed, will be issued under section 14 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Roads to be Closed

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas; and temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

5. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any gas, electricity, water or telecommunications service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, drainage pipes, sewers, gas pipes and any other service apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
