

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)
(Notice under section 11(9)(d))

WIDENING OF FUK HANG TSUEN ROAD
(BETWEEN CASTLE PEAK ROAD—LAM TEI AND FUK HANG TSUEN LANE)

Notice is hereby given that under section 11(2)(b) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Chief Executive in Council has authorized the works and the use as described in G.N. 178 published on 10 January 2020 and 17 January 2020 with modifications described hereunder. The modifications include modifications to limit of works area, as shown on Modification Plan No. HWDTM101A-SK0052 ('the Modification Plan'); and modifications to resumption/clearance limit, as shown on Modification Resumption Plan No. TMM4252 ('the Modification Resumption Plan'). The Modification Plan and the Modification Resumption Plan have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The modifications are as follows:—

- (i) revision of the proposed footpath and amenity areas near the junction of Castle Peak Road—Lam Tei and Fuk Hang Tsuen Road and the associated limit of works area;
- (ii) addition of a proposed run-in/run-out near the junction of Castle Peak Road—Lam Tei and Fuk Hang Tsuen Road;
- (iii) revision of the proposed amenity area near the junction of Fuk Hang Tsuen Road and Lam Tei Main Street and the associated limit of works area; and
- (iv) revision of the resumption/clearance limit in relation to modifications as described in (i) and (iii) above, including reduction of the scale of proposed land resumption of Lots Nos. 780 RP (Portion), 812 S.A (Portion) and 826 (Portion) (formerly known as 826) all in D.D.130.
