## PWP ITEM NO. 6878TH (PART) UPGRADING OF DEEP BAY ROAD

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 278493/GZ/1000 to 278493/GZ/1007 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) widening of a section of Deep Bay Road of approximately 3.6 kilometres between Lau Fau Shan roundabout and Nim Wan Road from single track access road to single two-lane carriageway;
- (ii) construction of at-grade carriageways, elevated carriageways, at-grade footpaths, elevated footpaths, slopes and amenity areas;
- (iii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into at-grade footpaths, elevated footpaths, amenity areas and slopes;
- (iv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into at-grade carriageways, elevated carriageways, elevated footpaths, amenity areas and slopes;
- (v) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing amenity areas into at-grade carriageways, at-grade footpaths and slope;
- (vi) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing at-grade carriageways, elevated carriageways and at-grade footpaths;
- (vii) temporary closure of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas; and
- (viii) ancillary works including landscaping, drainage, lightings, slope improvement, electrical and mechanical works; implementation of environmental mitigation measures; and construction of noise barriers, retaining walls and traffic aids.
