#### INTRODUCTION

This report shows the work and initiatives of the Highways Department in fulfilling our environmental responsibilities through supporting the Clean Air Charter, environmental management, research and technology and stakeholder's engagement in the year 2020. Our environmental performance was well recognized with the winning of several environmental

awards in 2020. Our achievement of environmental objectives and targets for 2020, and environmental targets set for 2021 are also reported.

To reduce paper consumption, this report is published in English and Chinese on our website.

#### **DEPARTMENT PROFILE**

We are responsible for expanding and improving Hong Kong's road network in order to meet the growth in traffic demand, serve new development areas and facilitate the movement of people and goods both within the territory and across the boundary and at the same time contribute towards sustainable development. Besides, we maintain the integrity of the road network with particular emphasis on safety and serviceability, and implement local road infrastructure works to facilitate and cope with the public and private sector developments. In addition, we formulate plans for further development of the railway network. We also provide technical support and set standards for the construction and maintenance of the road network. We research into new materials, techniques and standards including environmentally friendly technologies, and evaluating their applicability in Hong Kong.

The Headquarters of the Highways Department are located in Ho Man Tin Government Offices, with sub-offices in North Point Government Offices, Cheung Sha Wan Government Offices, Trade and Industry Tower, Spectrum Tower, the Harbourfront Towers, Grand City Plaza, Cheung Sha Wan Plaza and Nan Fung Commercial Centre. We have an establishment of about 670 professional staff and about 1,860 technical/common and general grades staff. We maintain about 2,150 km of roads and some 13,071 roadside slopes within the territory. The total operating expenditure for the financial year 2020/21 is HK\$3,879 million.
