

LAND (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ORDINANCE (Chapter 28)

(Notice under section 18C(1)(a) for specification of time limit for submission of an application for the issue of an excavation permit and the extension of the period for which an excavation permit is valid)

Pursuant to section 18C(1)(a) of the Land (Miscellaneous Provisions) Ordinance (Chapter 28), notice is hereby given that the Director of Highways has specified the following time limit for submission of an application for the issue of an excavation permit and the extension of the period of an excavation permit:—

- (1) For Excavation Permit Management System users, the time limit for submission of an application for the issue of an excavation permit under section 10A(1) in relation to any excavation through the Excavation Permit Management System is at least five days (excluding Sunday and general holiday);
- (2) For Excavation Permit Management System users, the time limit for submission of an application for the extension of the period for which an excavation permit is valid under section 10A(3) in relation to any excavation through the Excavation Permit Management System is at least seven days (excluding Sunday and general holiday);
- (3) For those who are not Excavation Permit Management System users, the time limit for submission of an application for the issue of an excavation permit under section 10A(1) in relation to any excavation is at least eighteen days (excluding Sunday and general holiday); and
- (4) For those who are not Excavation Permit Management System users, the time limit for submission of an application for the extension of the period for which an excavation permit is valid under section 10A(3) in relation to any excavation is at least eighteen days (excluding Sunday and general holiday).

This notice supersedes G.N. 3836 gazetted on 23 June 2006 from the date of this notice.
