Attachment G-1 – Safety Awareness Training

All staff and contractors involved with excavation works shall receive UXO Safety Awareness Training. The key awareness issues that need to be known by contractors and maintenance staff include:

UXO Safety Requirements for Excavations

- Staff should be vigilant at all times the potential UXO hazard that exists and report suspected UXO to supervisors.
- Work should stop if staff suspect they have encountered an UXO.
- The suspected UXO should not be touched or investigated by staff or contractors.

The types of ordnance that could be encountered and hazards therein

- High explosive shells up to 152mm diameter could be encountered. These represent a hazard and should only be handled or removed by the HKPF EODB.
- Grenades of approximately 50mm diameter could be encountered. These represent an extreme hazard and should only be handled or removed by the HKPF EODB.
